OPENSOURCE Nomadic Gallery is pleased to announce its inaugural show at its new location in Tribeca. The gallery will open its doors on Friday, November 11, 2016, with a solo exhibition by Pipi Deer called *remnants*.

The centerpiece of this exhibition is the installation *remnants*, 40 objects of significance, sealed in zip lock bags, affixed directly to a wall. The sealed bags preserve what is lost: memories, death, beauty; each tracing back to a time and place, mostly forgotten. Each object is heart-felt, with a deeply personal history. These relics have a definite aura, infused with life essence, refusing to be tossed away. Each separate bag and its object holds a life, slowly dying. Also part of the exhibition are two photographs and a piece of sculpture, further fragments of a fading past.
